One of the things often overlooked and not mentioned when we are talking about preparing our birds for show are the nasty STUBS that can be found on the legs or feet of many breeds. STUBS are a disqualification when showing. If you don't see them usually a judge will. Also, some stubs are so small you almost need a magnifying glass to see them. They can be hard to see on a dark legged bird if the stubs are tiny and black. So, keep your eyes open. Don't think just because you have a clean legged breed that stubs can't appear. They can!
