There are multiple duties of the national coordinator. A person must have some computer skills and be familiar with programs such as Excel, MS Word, PayPal and other programs. Keeping membership records, learning about the programs that are available for our members, such as the ACE Program, the Pre-Apprentice Judges program and our Showmanship Sanctioning program, working with our state leaders, packing and mailing materials and ordering supplies are a few of the duties. Traveling and attending shows to set up a club table is a bonus and with pre-approval from the YEPA board of directors, some reimbursement is sometimes available towards travel expense.

Hours are variable. Approximately 20 hours per week are usual but there are times it is less and at times they may be more.
